NEWS FROM DANIEL AND CONNIE TURNER



Dear Friends,

The past few weeks have been busy ones. We ended April with a 4 day outreach to the Maesot area, on the Burmese border.

There we met with our co workers Leo and Dulci who had identified several villages in the Maesot area where we took our puppets, skits and other stuff.

Though they are Karen villages, they had been largely un-evangelized.

We had good attentive crowds of all age groups, since I guess we were the biggest show in town anyways. We had to cancel the 3rd day's meeting as everyone in our team were immobilized (or otherwise) with some kind of stomach bug. All 6 of us spent most of that day moaning and laying around the Maesot church where we were staying.

The last day we went out with a bang at the Friday market in Maesot town. Crowds of 40 to 50 people stood around to watch our skits and receive tracts throughout the afternoon and into the evening. By Monday morning we had already received a response from a girl who was interested in knowing the Lord. She has now been inducted into a local fellowship.

We just now returned from a week long outreach to Chachoengsao (a city east of Bangkok) which is a 5 or 6 hour drive from here (some say 4 hours, but they are just gloating, because they have new cars).

We had a great time with the church planting team there evangelizing in markets. The last time we went there was in February, and 2 cell meetings have already started as a result of that thrust. This time around we did more of the same, and saw some immediate response. A few irate phone calls, and many seekers.

In a market at Bang Wuwa, we were blessed by the assistance of Mrs. Wassana, who was a fruit of the previous outreach in that place. We also had the opportunity to fellowship with Mr. Bon, who just gave his life to the Lord last week, and was first contacted during the outreach in February. This Friday we leave for a similar trip to help the Samngao church planting team in Tak province.
