



# Christ is the Answer Ukraine Tent Ministry - News from the Battlefield Henry, Julia and the Team - March 2010

Dear Brothers and friends,

It is time to write our latest news for you to know what is going on in our ministry.

We are living in the time our Lord told about in Mathew 24 and Mark 13. What is happening today warns us about the beginning of pain described in the Scripture, and about our responsibility to pray for this world that is going through such catastrophes as in Haiti and Chile, and countries where the violence reigns in all its forms: wars, rumor of wars, persecution of the church, etc.

We thank God for the blessing of being alive and the privilege to serve Him in the mission field; especially in this country that, I believe, is getting ready to become a platform for missionaries to be send to the rest of the world, before the second coming of our Lord.

Last year, after the campaigns in August and September, I had the blessed opportunity to go to Portugal to share with the churches about the work in Ukraine. Their response was great, I found help and support from dear brothers, that still remember the times when "Christ is the Answer" worked in Portugal.

By the grace of God, it was possible to arrange a contract with the company of electricity that warranted us the possibility to use the electrical heaters during winter. (Something we asked you to pray about in the last Newsletter).

God used this time dear brothers and sisters from a very small community in Kiev. They collected a large offering that was brought to us by some of its members. Glory to God! This gave the possibility for our disciples to begin their studies in the Bible Institute. They do it with much joy and expectation, it will surely help them to be more effective in the ministry. Then, followed a period of practical work – mostly mechanic and fixing the containers of families.

From October till December, some disciples, together with members of another mission, were practicing a Puppet and Marionettes Christmas program, to be shown later, from January till February in different orphanages of four regions of Ukraine. At the end of November till middle December, was sent an evangelistic outreach to work with the Church in the Dnepropetrovsk Region.

### **With the help of the Lord, our goals for this year are:**

- To see more people getting saved and joining the different communities.
- To continue working in the orphanages with "Agape" mission;
- To help the church of Dnepropetrovsk Region to begin at least two more communities, and reinforce three or four more.
- To find a place to use as our future winter quarters, where we will prepare disciples and to shelter to young Christians in need of strong Christian foundation, with the possibility to receive further education to prepare them to face the life's challenges or, if some will get the calling, to join the mission field.
- To accomplish all what we planned for this year we need you prayers, primarily for our spiritual equipment and for those who will listen to the message; then for the necessary things we need to do the practical work and the campaigns.

### Some of these needs are:

- Complete renewing of our musical system. (Around 2000.00 US \$).
- A new keyboard and guitar.
- A new small tent for meetings in villages. (Around 4000.00 US \$).
- 2 or 3 new containers for families and storage. (Around 1200.00 US \$ each container).
- A new radiator for our truck DAF. (630.00 US \$).
- Paint for the trucks and vans.
- Reparation of benches for the tents. (Around 500.00 US \$).

### Beside this we have our monthly expenses:

- Food: 600.00 US \$
- Hygienic products: 40.00 US \$
- Electricity bill: 125.00 US \$
- Water bill: 70.00 US \$
- Diesel (inside the city): 250.00 US \$. (Approximately).

And another very special prayer request:

For few years already, my wife and I have been feeling a burden for Venezuela. We think that is coming the time to begin our ministry there. Till now it have been only a dream or vision; and it does not look possible at the moment.

We have not many contacts there, not a place where to begin, and it will be necessary to take care of several things here and there, including the preparation of a responsible for the Ukrainian team, a school for our daughter, and finances for both missions.

In reality, we want to work between Ukraine and Venezuela, with the possibility to have interchange of missionaries, but this looks as a dream greater than anything I have been able to do till now. We need to know that it is the Lord leading to make the move with His clear direction and not our own desire. Please pray with us about it.

Right now Venezuela is facing much political instability and in the same time great openness and hunger for the Truth.

I will like to finish with the same thought I finished the other newsletter:

We want and we will go on with the Ministry as far as the Lord will lead us!  
You and our team, working together as one Body – His Body!
