STILL "TRUCKING FOR JESUS"

This prayer letter is way over due. Sorry about that! I really appreciate all those who care, in the first place, about us, and in the second place, about what we are doing here in Romania.

To say the least these last several months of 2010 have not been – how can I say – the easiest! But through it all, because of God's faithfulness, and the prayers of God's people on my behalf, I am still, as we use to say in the Jesus People days – trucking for Jesus!

With this prayer letter I would like to give testimony to God's faithfulness! Here is a recap of the last few months. Praise the Lord with me!

MARCH 2010:

As we continued to organize evangelism in south Romania in the region of Oltenia, I had an annual PSA blood test with a very bad result, to say the least, of 125.

APRIL 2010:

Returning to the doctor who operated on me last year with the PSA blood test results, after six weeks of antibiotics, he retests me, and the result is even worse than in March - 142!

God in His faithfulness speaks to me through Isaiah 43.2. I did not want to receive it, though, at that time!

Nevertheless we are lead by the Spirit to continue with the plans for evangelism in Oltenia by moving the tent to south Romania. This was a huge risk on our part knowing, that in order to use the tent more than once this last summer, we would need help from outside of Romania, and from other parts of Romania.

MAY AND JUNE 2010:

I had a bone scan, and two MRI's. One of the MRI's shows that I have cancer in my prostate and that it had metastasized to the area around my prostate.

Bad news!

In prayer the Lord gives me – Matthew 6.33.

Offered financial help through a dear brother to return to the USA for tests, but decide to remain in Romania.

Conduct together with three local churches a month long evangelism in the tent in Slatina.

PTL for those who were converted, and for those believers that participated in the evangelism which was new



experience for them, outside their box, so to speak, that is the four walls of their church buildings!

During this evangelism I return to Arad to have a biopsy which shows that the cancer in my body is aggressive. (9 on the Gleason Score). Worst news, but not the last word. The last word is: by His stripes we are healed.

Begin cancer treatment and a natural herbal treatment called Essiac.

JULY 2010 – AUGUST 2010:

Disappointment:

Because we are not able to set the tent up again in Otenia. First because of – I am sorry to say – certain church politics, in the middle of which we find ourselves. And secondly we are not able to set the tent up again because the help that we were praying for, and expecting, does not come. (I thank God, though, for those who prayed about coming, and considered coming.)

Because we were not able to set the tent up again we decided to do a different kind of evangelism first in the county of Arad where we live and then later in the county of Olt in Oltenia.

But in the county of Arad we have trouble from the local Orthodox priest who resists openly our evangelism in a town by the name of Sanpetru German.

Nevertheless we go ahead with



meetings in a public hall that we rented. But because of the Orthodox priests resistance there is poor attendance.

Encouragement:

Before going for the third cancer treatment I have a PSA blood test done that the doctor wanted to see thinking that she was going to have to up the dosage or treat me with radiation.

My PSA test result – 0.84! (It went from 142 in April to 0.84 in August.)

The doctor says – it means that the disease is under control.

A visit from my daughter and my grand kids for more than two weeks! And they help with the evangelism in San Petru German! What a blessing – grand kids!



SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER 2010:

More encouragement: Returning to Oltenia to do evangelism in a town called Piatra Olt. There was no evangelical church in this town 12 miles from Slatina. We had planned to set the tent up there. We had favor with the mayor to set the tent up right in the middle of the town. But in the end we could not do so. We had to program another kind of evangelism. Not wanting to give the local Orthodox priest an opportunity to resist the evangelism we do things different from Sanpetru German. Instead of doing a two week evangelism giving the Orthodox priest a Sunday to speak against us between announcing the public meetings in a local sport hall, and the actual public meetings, we do everything in one week.

We needed to be smarter than your average local Orthodox priest!

The believers from Slatina with whom we are working, to whom we had promised to do this, are nervous about the evangelism. Why? Again because they had never done this kind of activity before, and they are afraid that no one is going to come!

But people do come to both nights of the evangelism! The pastor from Slatina with whom we are working is able to make good contact with several people and follows up on them the next week. He was able to receive from the mayor a room to use for meetings, which he begins. The local Orthodox priest speaks against the mayor the next Sunday accusing him of letting a cult into Piatra Olt! But he really shots himself in the foot because the present mayor of Piatra Olt is popular.

We now regret even more that we could not set the tent up, but we are encouraged by the fact of fruit from the evangelism. Seven people declare

and show their faith in Jesus Christ. We thank God for this result after the long hard summer we had!



SEPTEMBER 16 – OCTOBER 5:

I traveled to the USA sponsored by a dear brother in Christ.

Attended a wonderful mission weekend at Bridge of Life Church in Hagerstown, MD.

Attended the Alliance International Ministries Summit in Maryland, where I was invited to minister and where I was mightily ministered to.

Traveled to Chicago.

Spent some wonderful time with friends and brothers in my home town.

Spent some wonderful days visiting sponsoring churches in Atlanta, and Lincoln, IL.

I was able as well to visit with some other brothers and Pastors as well.

Traveled to Dubois, PA where I participate in the annual and blessed mission conference of Smithtown Community Church.

This small, but very mission minded church, decides to start to sponsor me, as it continues to sponsor many other missionaries around the world.


Please continue to pray for our ministry here to the unconverted and to the converted as well!
